SEWER SYSTEM PROHIBITED WASTES

In light of the recent issue the Authority had with home heating fuel being discharged into the wastewater system and the subsequent damage to the system, the Board would like all wastewater customers to be aware that if this should happen again, the homeowner will be held liable for any and all damages pertaining to the clean-up and restart of the plant. Please have your HVAC technician inspect your oil tanks for any problems. Rules and Regulations concerning the discharge of prohibited wastes and unlawful connections may be viewed through the Authority website LMTMA.COM.

WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

POOL FILLING

If a consumer desires to fill or add water (300 gallons or more) to a swimming pool, the consumer must contact the Authority or its operator to obtain the written permission as to the time, date and amount of water which the consumer may use to fill or add to the pool and any restrictions that may be placed upon the water service at that time. If the consumer violates this provision, the water service to the property may immediately be terminated without prior notice and in addition, the violator shall be subject to the payment for the cost for termination or restoration of service, the actual or estimated amount of water used and a penalty of \$300 for damage to the water system. RESURFACING OR CEMENTING

The Authority would like to remind all its customers that if you are planning to resurface your driveway, cement new sidewalks or any other work that would come in contact with your water or wastewater service lines, you must contact our operator at 570-274-0554 at least 48 hours in advance of the work to be performed on your property.
